### Sex Offender Level III Notification

The Lewis County Sheriff's Office is releasing the following information pursuant to RCW 4.24.50, which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public when the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the Sheriff's Office. Further, their previous history places them in a classification level that reflects the potential to re-offend. The individual served the sentence imposed by the court and has properly notified the Sheriff's Office of their current address. The law does not require this offender to do anything other than register. **THEY ARE NOT WANTED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AT THIS TIME. **Synopsis of Information: In 2009 Walker was found guilty in Grays Harbor Superior Court for the crime of Child Molestation 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree. The offense involved Walker, when he was 47-years old, having sexual contact with a known 13-year old female. Walker was sentenced to between 48-120 months in prison for this crime and will be on Department of Corrections Community Supervision for the next 7 years. Walker has a previous 1981 conviction of Rape 3<sup>rd</sup>. This**

**involved Walker, 19 at the time, having forced sexual contact with a 17-year old known female. Other convictions include Burglary 2<sup>nd</sup> and Unlawful Issuance of Bank Checks. Based on Walker's history, and the type of crimes committed, Walker has been classified as a high risk to re-offend and this community notification is being made.**

Using this public information to threaten, intimidate or harass sex offenders will not be tolerated by the law enforcement agencies of Lewis County. This abuse could potentially terminate our ability to release this important information to the public.
